

#### Hydrilla is an invasive aquatic plant known for:

- · Choking native aquatic species
- · Hitchhiking unauthorized on boats
- · Obstructing swimming and fishing
- Hijacking the local economy

#### Here's how to spot it:

- Elongated stem
- Small, blade-shaped leaves with toothy edges
- · Whorls of 5 leaves along the stem
- Grows an inch per day up to 30 feet in length

### **Spotted Lanternfly is often** misidentified as other common insects. Here's how to spot it:

- · One inch long
- Gray-brown forewings with black spots
- · Bright red underwings
- Gathers on trees, especially tree of heaven
