



# WANTED: HYDRILLA



**Hydrilla is an invasive aquatic plant known for:**

- **Choking** native aquatic species
- **Hitchhiking** unauthorized on boats
- **Obstructing** swimming and fishing
- **Hijacking** the local economy

**Here's how to spot it:**

- **Elongated** stem
- **Small, blade-shaped** leaves with toothy edges
- **Whorls of 5 leaves** along the stem
- **Grows an inch** per day up to 30 feet in length

**Spotted Lanternfly is an invasive pest known for:**

- **Destroying** crop and plant species
- **Vandalizing** with black mold
- **Threatening** food, beer and wine industries
- **Sabotaging** the local economy

**Spotted Lanternfly is often misidentified as other common insects. Here's how to spot it:**

- **One inch** long
- **Gray-brown** forewings with black spots
- **Bright red** underwings
- **Gathers on trees**, especially tree of heaven
